Any citizen wishing to make a formal request for information may fill out Colorado Open Records Act request form. The statute gives everyone broad access to government records throughout the state. You can complete a hardcopy request and mail it to:

What is CORA?

"CORA" stands for "Colorado Open Records Act" In the spirit of open government, the Colorado Open Records Act (24-72-201 to 24-72-309, C.R.S.) requires that most public records be available to the public. Anyone can request information that is in the possession of our office.
