



**PROGRAM PARTNER AMENDMENT TO
GENERAL MEMBER AFFILIATE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**

This document serves as an Amendment to the General Member Affiliate Memorandum of Understanding (GM MOU) between **GOAL Academy**, hereinafter referred to as "Program Partner" and the National Council of La Raza (NCLR). If this Amendment terminates or expires, the terms and conditions of the General Member MOU shall continue to be in effect. The term of this Amendment shall be for a period of 12 months, commencing on **January 1, 2015** and shall continue in full force and effect until **December 31, 2015**. NCLR and the Program Partner shall reserve the absolute right to terminate this Amendment at any time without liability, except as may be specifically provided in a sub-grant agreement.

Furthermore, this Amendment is incorporated into all existing subgrant agreements or understandings pertaining to the subject matter hereof whether written or oral.

Program Partner Amendment and Fee: The Affiliate Sub-grantee is required to sign this Program Partner Amendment and pay a Grant Administration Fee of \$500. The Grant Administration Fee is used to offset NCLR's support and administration of the Grant. The Grant Administration Fee will be discounted from the first grant payment and it is nonrefundable should the partnership terminate before the end of the stated period. This fee is in addition to the Affiliate's annual NCLR General Membership dues. Failure to sign the Partner Amendment, pay the Grant Administration Fee, and/or comply with NCLR General Member requirements (Affiliates) will result in termination of this sub-grant agreement.

Program Partner

Program Partner meets the following criteria:

- Meets the capacity requirements established by NCLR program staff
- Has a resource exchange (grants or in-kind services) and a manner in which the Program Partner and NCLR will communicate about program strategy, methods, and outcomes
- Offers a program(s) developed to meet the specific needs of the Latino population
- Agrees to either:
 - Document the methods and strategies to be tested in a new program, generate data required to illustrate outcomes, and cooperate with program funders as needed by NCLR; or
 - Implement methods and strategies that NCLR is proposing for the program, generate data required to illustrate outcomes, and cooperate with program funders as needed by NCLR

A. During the term of this Amendment, NCLR agrees to provide the following services and benefits to Program Partner:

19. Program Partner will receive all relevant program materials and technical support for the NCLR programs it is implementing.
20. NCLR will promote the program nationally, regionally, or locally, as available resources allow.
21. If Program Partner has developed model programs, NCLR will provide support for the documentation of the program and funding for program staff to serve as trainers for other Affiliates, as available resources allow.

22. NCLR will support the Program Partner in either developing or implementing available data systems to document impact, and will train as necessary to track outcome data.
23. The Program Partner will be invited to showcase its experiences at periodic knowledge-sharing forums, as available resources allow.
24. The Program Partner may receive subgrants to implement the agreed-upon program.


B. During the term of this Amendment, the Program Partner is an active participant and collaborator in a major program initiative of NCLR's which requires field implementation. Specifically:

16. The Program Partner focused on creating a new program is expected to identify, codify, and report on the core elements of the program(s) in cooperation with NCLR.
17. The Program Partner focused on replicating NCLR's programs is expected to implement the model with fidelity and identify challenges and potential modifications.
18. The Program Partner must participate in all evaluation activities and collect data on program outcomes, regardless of whether it is implementing a new program or replicating an existing program.
19. The Program Partner will participate in knowledge-sharing sessions or other events critical to the program's success, as appropriate.
20. The Program Partner must make itself available for funder site visits.


C. NCLR Program Sub-grants

The NATIONAL COUNCIL OF LA RAZA and GOAL Academy agree to meet the terms and conditions stated above.




