- Believe that all students can learn
- Concept that we want our students to graduate – when they graduate with a high school diploma, it means a lot within the community in terms of their ability to give back to the community and their wellbeing and ability to earn a livable wage.
- Show up – connect – succeed goes hand in hand with Stabilize – engage – grow. This is how we're measured on SPF, truancy rate, APR
- Where we struggle: truancy and drop out
- Students need to feel like they belong to feel connected to school
- The more a student knows about themselves, the more successful they will be in workplace and for their own future.
- 88% meets – attendance – doesn't put us in category we need for truancy – not directly correlated
- When a student is checking in but not working in classes – still truant? We'll get there eventually
- Need to live in "connect" in order to improve passer ratings, lower truancy etc.
