## SAT and CMAS-Science testing information

All Juniors will take the SAT test on **April 12, 2023**. The SAT takes approximately 5 hours. The test will be at your local GOAL site unless the space at the site isn't adequate for testing. In those cases, the test will be at a different off-site location. You'll receive more information about the location and time of the test as we get closer to test day, but mark your calendars, and be sure you are available **Wednesday, April 12<sup>th</sup>**. The SAT test takes approximately 5 hours.

Juniors will also take the CMAS-Science test during the week of April 17-21. This test is completed using the student's GOAL issued computer and takes approximately 3 hours. It's important that you turn your GOAL computer on before coming to the site to test and allow the computer to update. Please bring your computer and your charger.

You will get specific information closer to the test date on where and when to report for testing.

State assessments play an important role in checking student progress so informed decisions can be made to tailor and invest in educational programs. In short, assessments show us what students know and where they can grow!

Assessments give us valuable information about the effectiveness of our teaching practices and guide our improvement planning. State tests also provide our community with information about how our school is performing.
