- GOAL Academy's Board of Directors determines that appropriate behavior on GOAL Academy property is necessary to ensure the welfare and safety of students and school personnel.

### 6. The Policy

## **I. School Policy**

Persons using or upon GOAL Academy property, including all buildings, parking lots, and any vehicle used to transport students, and or staff, shall not engage in the conduct described below.

1. Any conduct that obstructs, disrupts, or interferes with teaching, research, service, administrative, or disciplinary functions, or any activity sponsored or approved by the Board.
2. Physical abuse or threat of harm to any person at GOAL Academy sponsored or supervised functions.
3. Threat of damage, or damage to property of GOAL Academy regardless of the location, or property of a member of the community or a visitor to GOAL Academy when such property is located on GOAL Academy controlled premises.
4. Forceful or unauthorized entry to or occupation of GOAL Academy facilities, including both buildings and grounds.
5. Use, possession, distribution or sale of drugs and other controlled substances, alcohol and other illegal contraband on GOAL Academy property, or school-sponsored functions or in any vehicle transporting students. For purposes of this policy, "controlled substances" means drugs identified and regulated under federal law, including but not limited to marijuana, cocaine, opiates, phencyclidine (PCP) and amphetamines (including methamphetamine).
6. Distribution, manufacture or sale of controlled substances or the possession of controlled substances with intent to distribute them within 1,000 feet of the perimeter of GOAL Academy property.
7. Profanity or verbally abusive language.
8. Unlawful use of any tobacco product, to include e-cigarettes.
9. Entry onto GOAL Academy grounds or building by a person suspected or known to be under the influence of alcohol or a controlled substance.
10. Unlawful possession of a deadly or dangerous weapon, as defined in state law, on GOAL Academy property or in a GOAL Academy site.
11. Violation of any federal, state or municipal law or Board policy.

Any member of the general public considered by the Chief Executive Officer or designee to be in violation of this policy shall be instructed to leave the premises.
