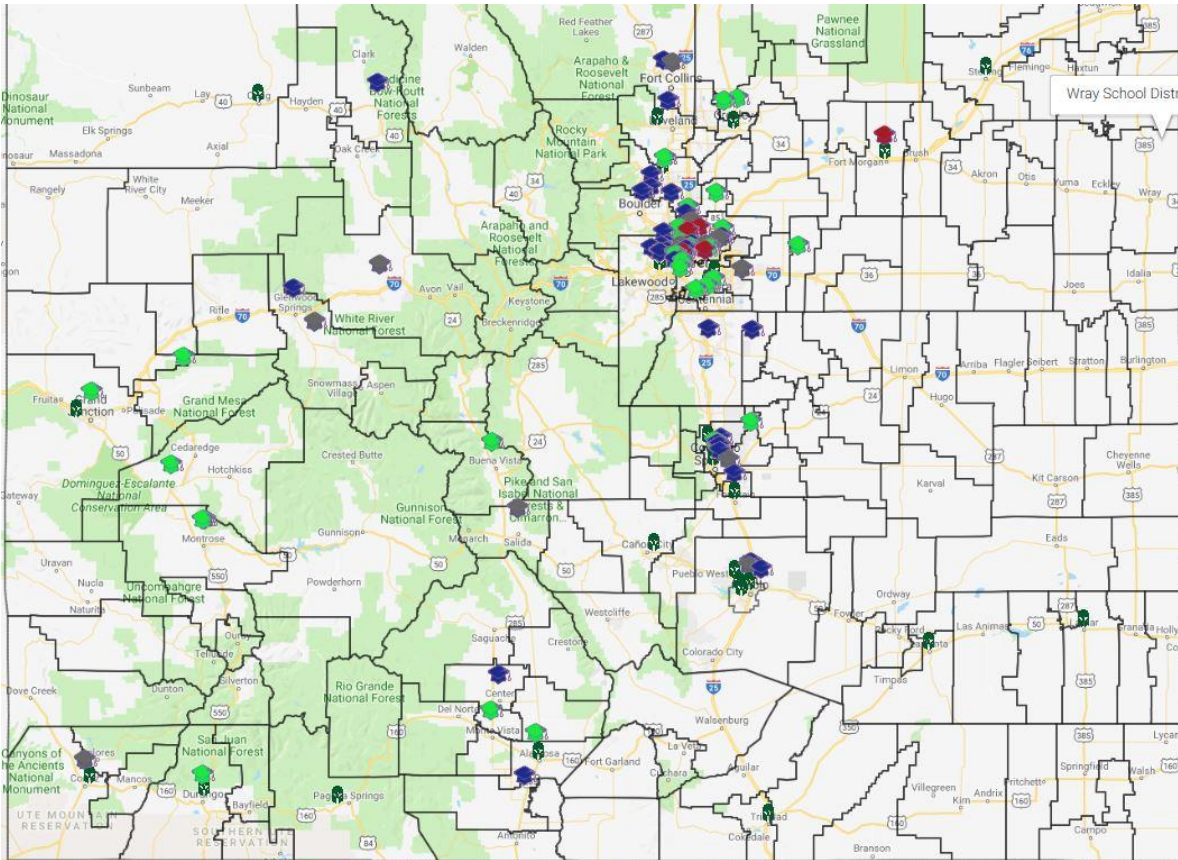


# Alternative Education Campus (AEC) Comparability Report

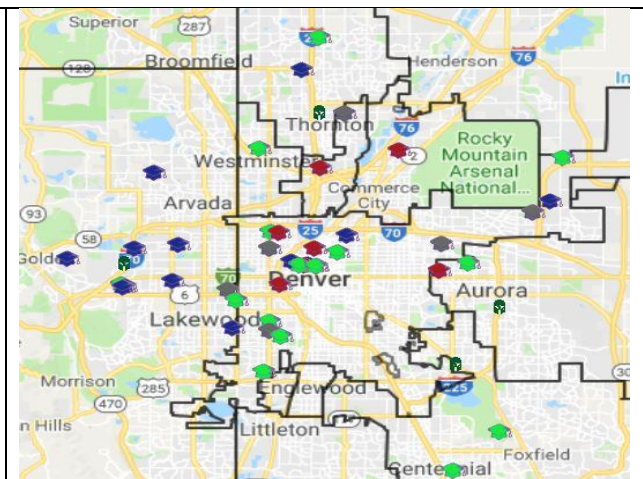
Quick Facts: Number of AEC's:

- Statewide = 92
- 100% special education ~ 5
- Specifically designed for teen parents: 2



In the Denver area there are 45 AEC campuses:

- 3 in Douglas County
- 11 in Jefferson County
- 1 in Mapleton
- 1 in Westminster
- 3 in Adams 12 and Adams 14
- 1 in Arapahoe
- 21 in Denver County
- 1 in Cherry Creek
- 3 in Denver through CSI



How are the schools doing? (by dropout rates)

- Blue -> Schools with drop out rates below 11%
- Green -> between 11 -21%
- Grey -> between 21-31%
- Red -> drop out rates above 31%
