Purpose

In accordance with Colorado House Bill 25-1135, GOAL Academy permits students to possess and use personal mobile communication devices, including cell phones and smartwatches, during their participation in the online learning environment, under the following conditions:

Appropriate Use:

Devices may be used to support learning activities, access course materials, and communicate with instructors or peers as needed.

Prohibited Use:

Recording or sharing class sessions without permission is not allowed.

Use of devices for non-educational purposes during scheduled instructional time is discouraged.

Use of devices at any time during a State or school-wide test or assessment is not allowed.

Exceptions:

Students with documented medical needs or accommodations (e.g., IEPs, 504 Plans) may use devices as required.

Emergency use is permitted at any time.

Enforcement:

Violations may result in progressive disciplinary action, including warnings, parent contact, or restricted access to school platforms.

Responsibility:

Students are responsible for the appropriate use and security of their devices. The school is not liable for technical issues or data loss on personal devices.
